This funding will be used to

- Build confidence and capability of staff in a range of Augmentive and Alternative Communication (AAC) systems to meet the diverse communication needs of all students.
- Strengthen the data literacy capabilities of teachers and school leaders by building upon existing collegial engagement processes.
- Implement with fidelity a systematic and differentiated approach to Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) across the phases of the school.
- Enhance outdoor play and learning areas to support highly effective teaching strategies and pedagogies.

Our initiatives include

- Additional teacher release time to support collegial engagement for the moderation and case management processes.
- Opportunities for teachers and teacher aides to engage in effective professional development, coaching and observational feedback to improve teaching practices in priority areas.
- Provision of ICT software and hardware and low-tech options to support student access to AAC.
- Provision of loose parts play equipment to support outdoor learning opportunities based upon pedagogical approaches including WP Investigations and process-based learning.
- Provision of resources to support implementation of the Indigenous Languages Program.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Funding professional development costs and release time for teachers and teacher aides to engage with coaches, mentors, collaborative planning and targeted professional development. | \$45 000 |
| • Purchasing ICT hardware and software to support communication development. | \$10 000 |
| • Purchasing visual supports and low-tech multi-modal communication systems to support communication across environments. | \$5 000 |
| • Purchasing of loose parts play equipment for outdoor learning areas and resources to support implementation of Indigenous Languages Program. | \$9 664 |
